ELIGIBILITY:

- ◆ All individuals in the Category of General Contractor, Professional Engineer or Architect possessing appropriate license.
- ◆ CACP officers, board members, staffs and their immediate family members are NOT ELIGIBLE.
- ◆ Applicant must be a small business concern as defined by any public agency in the Southern California area as of the application date.

REQUIREMENTS:

- ◆ **Nominations** must be submitted by **5PM on January 8, 2009**.
- ◆ **Candidates** accepting nomination are required to **submit 3 projects** completed during the period of January 1, 2006 and November 30, 2008 along with a **completed application form**.
- ◆ **Deadline:** Application must be submitted by **5PM on January 19, 2009** to the CACP office.
- ◆ Each candidate will be provided an opportunity to participate in a radio interview with EDI Media Corp. Candidate must be available.
- ◆ The judging panel comprised of an architect, an engineer and a general contractor will make the final selection. An interview may be requested of the applicant. Applicant must be available.
- ◆ **Winners must be present** at the award ceremony on **February 21, 2009** at **Empress Harbor Restaurant in Monterey Park**.
- ◆ **Winners must be available for media interview by EDI Media, Inc. between Jan. 20 ~ Feb. 14, 2009.**

CRITERIA:

Criteria for the final selection will be evaluated based on the following:

Project quality	Design and/or construction quality as determined by the professional's involvement in the project	50%
Project Control	Aspect of design or construction control as demonstrated by the project submitted	20%
Environmental Conscientiousness	Respect to the environment (includes energy conservation)	5%
Neighborhood Consideration	Coordination with adjacent properties owners demonstrating a "good-neighbor" operation policy	5%
Social Conscientiousness	On-going community involvement and support for various positive causes, etc.	5%
Presentation	Interview and Presentation	15%
