

Directions To Edwards Air Force Base CA

FROM LOS ANGELES: Interstate highway 5 (Golden State Freeway) to state highway 14 (Antelope Valley Freeway) through Palmdale and Lancaster to Rosamond, turn off at Rosamond Blvd. exit, turn east (right), follow signs to Edwards AFB. The Air Force west gate security guard station is approximately eight miles inside the west boundary of the base. Approximate travel time from Los Angeles is two to 2½ half hours.

FROM RENO/BISHOP: Highway 395 to Highway 14 to Mojave, turn left onto Highway 58. Follow signs to Edwards AFB. Travel approximately 20 miles to the Edwards AFB north gate. Enter the base via this gate; continue on Rosamond Blvd. Approximate travel time is three hours from Bishop, eight hours from Reno.

FROM PALMDALE/LANCASTER: Highway 14 (Antelope Valley Freeway) north to Rosamond, turn off at Rosamond Blvd. exit, turn east (right), follow signs to Edwards AFB. Air Force security guard station is approximately eight miles inside west boundary of base. Continue on Rosamond Blvd. Approximate travel time 40 to 50 minutes.

FROM SAN FRANCISCO/SACRAMENTO/FRESNO/BAKERSFIELD: Take Interstate 5 or Highway 99 to Bakersfield, then take Highway 58 east to Mojave. Continue on Hwy. 58 east from Mojave approximately 20 miles to the Edwards AFB north gate exit. Enter base via this gate; continue on Rosamond Blvd. Approximate travel time 1½ to two hours from Bakersfield, 3½ hours from Fresno, seven hours from San Francisco/Sacramento.

TO ALL VISITORS: When you arrive at a gate entering Edwards AFB, tell the guard your destination. *You must have proof of insurance showing the effective date and expiration date, two forms of photo identification including a valid driver's license with photo, and a current vehicle registration to be able to gain access to Edwards AFB.*
